

Agent Registration

Per USC 4-41a-205, each person employed in a medical cannabis cultivation, processing or lab facility must be a registered agent and be in possession of an agent card to work in their respective establishment. The following information must be submitted to the department for each agent:

- 1) The prospective agent's name and address;
- 2) The name and location of the licensed medical cannabis facility employing the prospective agent;
- 3) A fingerprint card in a form acceptable to the Department of Public Safety;
- 4) Sign a waiver in acknowledging the registration of the prospective agent's fingerprints in the Federal Bureau of Investigation Next Generation Identification System's Rap Back Service and comply with other requirements outlined in [4-41a-301\(B\)](#)
- 5) Pay the following fees:
 - a. Background Check - \$50.00
 - b. Agent Card Fee - \$100.00
- 6) Completion of a certification training approved by the department.

The department shall, within 15 business days after the day on which the department receives a complete application from a cannabis facility, issue an agent registration card to the prospective agent.
