Utah Medical Cannabis Cards for Non-Utah Residents

Visitors to the state of Utah who are medical cannabis card holders in their home state can apply for a temporary card that allows access to Utah Medical Cannabis pharmacies while they are visiting Utah. The cards are good for 21 days at a time, and patients may be issued two 21-day cards per calendar year.

These cards are available ONLY to patients who are diagnosed with a qualifying condition as determined by Utah law:

- acute pain
- acquired immune deficiency syndrome or HIV
- Alzheimer's disease
- amyotrophic lateral sclerosis
- cancer
- cachexia
- persistent pain lasting longer than two weeks
- Crohn's disease or ulcerative colitis
- epilepsy or debilitating seizures
- multiple sclerosis or persistent and debilitating muscle spasms
- post-traumatic stress disorder (PTSD)
- autism
- a terminal illness when the patient's life expectancy is less than six months
- a condition resulting in the individual receiving hospice care
- a rare condition or disease that affects less than 200,000 individuals in the U.S., as defined in federal law, and that is not adequately managed despite treatment attempts using conventional medications (other than opioids or opiates) or physical interventions

To register for a Non-Utah resident card:

1. Access the system at evs.utah.gov



All users must first establish a Utah-ID account to set up a user ID and password for the Electronic Verification System. Click "create an account" to start this process or you can do this step in advance at <u>id.utah.gov</u>
