

# Medical cannabis patient electronic verification system (EVS) guide

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### How do I get a medical cannabis card?

You'll apply for a medical cannabis card in the electronic verification system (EVS). The EVS is an online database that holds all of the medical cannabis cards, recommendations, and purchase data for patients and medical providers. You must register in the EVS to get a medical cannabis card.

After you register in the EVS, you'll meet in-person with your medical provider. You can find a list of medical providers at <u>https://medicalcannabis.utah.gov/patients/locate-a-provider/</u>.

### What do I need when I apply for a card in the electronic verification system (EVS)?

- A UtahID account
- Full name
- The last 4 digits of your social security number
- Date of birth
- Email address
- Address
- Government issued photo identification like a driver's license or passport

#### What is a UtahID?

UtahID is a state-wide account that you'll use to verify your identity before you log into the EVS. If you have a UtahID for other programs, use the same one when you apply for a medical cannabis card. You don't need to make a new UtahID just for medical cannabis.

#### How do I sign up for a UtahID?

Follow these steps to sign up for a UtahID if you don't already have one.

1. Go to evs.utah.gov and click the "Log in" button at the top right.



2. Follow the steps at <u>https://dts.utah.gov/idhelp/account-creation/</u>to create your account.

# How do I create an account in the electronic verification system (EVS)?

1. Log in to EVS at evs.utah.gov using your UtahID.



- 2. You will be taken to a screen with a "Complete your registration" header.
- 3. Select "Patient" under the "Register as" heading. You can add more cards later. If you are applying for your minor child, select "Patient".
- 4. Enter all the required details. Required information is marked with a red star. Make sure you enter this information correctly, because you won't be able to change it later.
- 5. Click the "Submit" button.
- 6. You'll be redirected to the EVS home screen where you can see your account information.

# How do I submit a medical cannabis application in the electronic verification system (EVS)?

1. Go to evs.utah.gov and click the "Log in" button at the top right.




- 2. You will be taken to the UtahID log in page. Log in with your UtahID.
- 3. On your electronic verification system (EVS) account page, click the "Patient" button on the left hand side.

4. Click the "Add application" button under the "My profile actions" heading.



- 5. Choose "Utah resident" from the "Registration type" drop-down menu.
- 6. Choose "I am applying for myself" from the "Applicant type" drop-down menu if you're applying for a card for yourself. Click the "Next" button on the right side of the screen.
- 7. Choose "I'm applying on behalf of my minor child" from the "Applicant type" drop-down menu if you're applying for a card for your child who is younger than 18 years. Click the "Next" button on the right side of the screen.



- 8. While working on your application, you can click the "Save" link on the left side of the page to save your application and finish it at another time. You can cancel your application completely by clicking the "Cancel link" on the left side of the page.
- 9. Enter your personal details. Required information is marked with a red star. Make sure your name matches exactly what is on your identification. Click the "Next" button on the right side of the screen.

### How do I renew my medical cannabis card?

Renewing your card is very similar to applying for your first card. You will use your same UtahID and EVS account.

You'll receive an email about renewing your card 30 days before your card expires. You can renew your card before it expires, but you won't get a new card until your current card expires.

Follow these steps to renew your card:

1. Go to evs.utah.gov and click the "Log in" button at the top right.



- 2. You will be taken to the UtahID log in page. Log in with your UtahID.
- 3. On your electronic verification system (EVS) account page, click the "Patient" button on the left hand side.



4. Click the "My application" button under the "My profile actions" heading.



5. Click on the application you need to renew under "Patient ID". Your application status will change to "Active pending renewal" 30 days before your card expires.

- 12. You'll get an email from us with instructions to pay your medical cannabis card fee after your provider submits your new medical cannabis certification in the EVS.

# How do I manage my medical cannabis card in the Electronic Verification System (EVS)?

There are a lot of ways that you can manage your medical cannabis card in the electronic verification system (EVS). You can see a copy of your medical cannabis card, keep track of your medical cannabis purchases, update your personal information, and add a caregiver to your account.

#### How do I see a copy of my medical cannabis card?


Your medical cannabis card is saved in your electronic verification system (EVS) account. You can download it to a smartphone or tablet or you can print a hard copy of it. We don't mail or email you a copy of your card.

- 3. On your electronic verification system (EVS) account page, click the "Patient" button on the left hand side.





7. Print or save your card to your smartphone or tablet. You must show your card every time you go to a medical cannabis pharmacy.

### How do I track my medical cannabis purchases in the electronic verification system (EVS)?


When you get your medical cannabis card, your medical provider or a medical cannabis pharmacist will work with you to figure out how much cannabis you should use each day. This is your monthly purchase limit. You can see your monthly purchase limit in your electronic verification system (EVS) account.

Follow these instructions to check your monthly purchase limit in the EVS:

# How do I manage medical cannabis caregivers on my account?

You can add and remove any medical cannabis caregivers in your electronic verification system (EVS) account. You can see all your caregivers by clicking on the "Caregiver" tab in your patient application.

#### What is a medical cannabis caregiver?


A medical cannabis caregiver is someone who you authorize to buy medical cannabis from medical cannabis pharmacies for you. You can add a medical cannabis caregiver to your account at any time.

### How do I add a medical cannabis caregiver to my electronic verification system (EVS) account?






#### How do I cancel my medical cannabis card?

You can cancel your medical cannabis card at any time in the electronic verification system (EVS). You can't legally buy, possess or use medical cannabis after your card is canceled.

2. On your electronic verification system (EVS) account page, click the "Patient" button on the left hand side.



3. Click the "My application" button under the "My profile actions" heading.



4. Click on your application under "Patient ID".


